The Academy of Sciences shall provide the Board with a written guarantee to reimburse the Board for the full salary, benefits, pension payments and related expenses that the Board pays to Ms. Bushwaller during the term of the Leave. TERM: The term of this Leave and reimbursement will begin August 29, 2001 and will end June 25, 2002. By mutual consent, and subject to Board approval, this Leave may be extended for up to a twelve (12) month period under the same terms and conditions of this Leave.

SCOPE OF DUTIES: Ms. Bushwaller will be working with the Nature Museum's Education Staff to help increase science knowledge and achievement of the natural science to Chicago Public School students and their teachers by participation in the following activities: Interacting with students and teachers on the museum floor; Interacting with students and teachers during museum workshops; In-service programs for teachers; and work with online departments for webcasting.


Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be followed.
