**REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF SAMUEL ALICEA, SCHOOL BUS AIDE,
BLAINE SCHOOL**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Samuel Alicea be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten 10 days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Samuel Alicea, a school bus aide currently assigned to the Blaine School, 1420 West Grace Street, Chicago, Illinois 60613, with violation of School rules, or Board rules, policies or procedures which result in behaviors that seriously disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off the school grounds or work location and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Samuel Alicea from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Samuel Alicea has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Samuel Alicea without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
