That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Andrew Jackson be approved; that notice of his dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon him within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Andrew Jackson, a Security Officer currently assigned to Sengstacke Academic Preparatory Center, 2641 South Calumet, Chicago, Illinois 60616, with use of profane gestures and threatening language; use of profane language or gestures in front of students; behaviors that seriously disrupts the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off the school grounds or assigned work location; conduct which is cruel, immoral, negligent, criminal, or causes psychological or physical harm or injury to a student; behavior that grossly disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off school grounds or assigned work location.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Andrew Jackson from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Andrew Jackson has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Andrew Jackson without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
