ORIGINAL AGREEMENT: The original affiliation agreements (authorized by Board Report No.: 98-0325-ED12) were for a term commencing March 25, 1998 and ending August 31, 1998, with unlimited options to renew for 12 month periods. The original agreements were renewed for the period commencing September 1, 1998 and ending August 31, 1999 pursuant to Board Report No.: 98-0429-ED4. By mutual agreement of the parties, the original agreements were renewed for a three-year term commencing September 1, 1999 and ending August 31, 2002, and such renewal document provides for renewals of periods of longer than one year upon mutual consent of the parities (authorized by Board Report No.: 99-0825-PR29).

OPTION PERIOD: By mutual consent of the parties, the term of each agreement is being renewed for three (3) years commencing September 1, 2002 and ending August 31, 2005.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING: There are unlimited option periods remaining.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written

option document. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the option document.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board member during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability – The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
