

**ADJUST THE ATTENDANCE BOUNDARY OF PHILLIPS AND ESTABLISH LOCAL SCHOOL
COUNCIL VOTING DISTRICT FOR DUSABLE HIGH SCHOOL**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective July 1, 2003, adjust the attendance boundary of Wendell Phillips Academy, located at 244 East Pershing Road and establish Jean Baptiste Point DuSable High School, located at 4934 South Wabash Avenue as a multi-attendance area school. This change is not applicable to students currently enrolled at Phillips Academy School.

DESCRIPTION: Effective July 1, 2003, the Jean Baptiste Point DuSable High School will not have a defined neighborhood attendance area. The described voting district boundary is the same as the current attendance boundary for DuSable High School.

 South to 59th Street
 West to the NYC RR
 North to Garfield Boulevard
 West to Normal Avenue
 North to 47th Street
 East to the Dan Ryan
 North to the starting point

Adjust Attendance Area Boundary for Wendell Phillips Academy

Grades ninth through twelfth:

Beginning at the North and South branches of the Chicago River
 East to Michigan Avenue
 South to Madison Street
 East to Lake Michigan
 South to 41st Street (extended)
 West to Drexel Boulevard
 North to 41st Street
 West to Dr Martin Luther King Junior Drive
 South to 59th Street
 West to the NYC RR
 North to Garfield Boulevard
 West to Normal Avenue
 North to 47th Street
 East to the Dan Ryan
 North to the CN RR at 40th Street
 West to the C&WI/Penn Central RR at Stewart Avenue
 North to the south branch of the Chicago River
 North along the river to the starting point






