

REPORT ON STUDENT EXPULSIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2003

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

12 Students were expelled from the Chicago Public Schools in September 2003.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 10-22.6 and 34-19 of the *School Code of Illinois*, Section 6-8 of the *Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago*, and the *Uniform Discipline Code* of the Chicago Public Schools, the Chief Education Officer approved the expulsion of 12 Chicago Public Schools students, for gross disobedience, misconduct or other violations of the bylaws, rules and regulations of the Chicago Board of Education.


