## ADJUST ATTENDANCE AREA BOUNDARIES AND CHANGE ASSOCIATED SMALL SCHOOLS FOR ORR CAMPUS HIGH SCHOOL AND ESTABLISH PHOENIX MILITARY ACADEMY AS A MULTI-ATTENDANCE AREA HIGH SCHOOL

## THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective August 1, 2005, adjust attendance area boundaries and change the associated small schools for Rezin Orr Campus High School located at 730 N Pulaski Road. Establish Phoenix Military Academy located at 145 S Campbell as a multi-attendance area high school.

## **DESCRIPTION:**

The Phoenix Military Academy will cease to occupy the Orr Campus. Incoming ninth graders residing within the Orr Campus attendance area will have a choice of attending the small schools of Moses Vines, AASTA, and Excel. Students currently enrolled at Phoenix Military Academy will have the option of attending these three schools or continue to remain enrolled in Phoenix Military Academy. Phoenix Military Academy will become a multi-attendance area high school housed in the current Grant Elementary School facility located at 145 S. Campbell Avenue.

## Adjust Attendance Area Boundary for Orr Campus High School:

Grades nine and ten: (effective August 1, 2005);

Beginning at Austin Boulevard and North Avenue East to Central Avenue South to Ohio Street West to Austin Boulevard North to Starting Point.

Grades ninth through twelfth: (effective August 1, 2005);

Beginning at Kenton Avenue and North Avenue East to Kedzie Avenue South to Augusta Boulevard East to Sacramento Service Drive South to Kinzie Street West to St. Louis Avenue South to Fulton Boulevard West to Central Park Avenue South to Lake Street West to Hamlin Boulevard South to Madison Street West to Keeler Avenue North to Kinzie Street East to Pulaski Road North to Chicago Avenue West to Kenton Avenue

North to Starting Point.
