

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH LIPPERT INC.
FOR THE PURCHASE OF LUNCHROOM REFRIGERATION EQUIPMENT**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Lippert Inc. for the purchase of lunchroom refrigeration equipment for Department of Logistics at a cost not to exceed \$700,000. Vendor was selected on a competitive basis pursuant to duly advertised Bid Solicitation (Specification No.: 07-250007). A written agreement for this purchase is available for signature. No goods may be ordered or received and no payment shall be made to Vendor prior to the execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. TERM: The term of this agreement shall commence on August 1, 2007 and shall end July 31, 2008. This agreement shall have one (1) option to renew for a period of (1) one year each or any shorter time as determined by Board. The pricing set forth in the agreement shall remain firm for the renewal period.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT: The Board shall have the right to terminate this agreement with 30 days written notice.

DESCRIPTION OF PURCHASE:

Goods: lunchroom refrigeration equipment
Quantity: required by the Board
Unit Price: as indicated in the contract
Total Cost Not to Exceed: \$700,000

OUTCOMES: This purchase will result in quality lunchroom refrigeration equipment.

COMPENSATION: Vendor shall be paid in accordance with the unit prices contained in the agreement; not to exceed the sum of \$700,000.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreement. Authorize Chief Operating Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: This contract is in full compliance with the goals required by the Revised Remedial Plan for Minority and Women Business Enterprise Contract Participation (M/WBE Plan). The M/WBE participation goals for the contract include: 26% total MBE and 5% total WBE.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted June 23, 2004 (04-0623-PO4), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.




