

**RATIFY TENTATIVE AGREEMENT FOR JULY 1, 2007 TO JUNE 30, 2012 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO AND THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS, LOCAL 134, AFL-CIO**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**


That the Board approve and ratify a tentative agreement for a collective bargaining agreement between the Board of Education of the City of Chicago and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 134 covering the period of July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2012.

**DESCRIPTION:** On August 1, 2007, representatives of the Chief Executive Officer reached a tentative agreement with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 134, AFL-CIO, with respect to the terms and conditions of employment of employees in the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 134, AFL-CIO bargaining unit. The Chief Executive Officer and his representatives have fully briefed the Board on the terms of the tentative agreement. Representatives of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 134, AFL-CIO advised the Chief Executive Officer's representatives that employees in the bargaining unit have ratified the tentative agreement. The Chief Executive Officer recommends that the Board ratify that agreement. A copy of the fully executed agreement will be placed on file in the Office of the Board.
