RESOLUTION DE-DESIGNATING THE PROPERTY AT 1217 WEST MONROE

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago (the "Board") is a body, corporate and politic organized and existing under and by virtue of the provisions of the school code 105 ILCS 5/34-1, as amended (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Board exercises general supervision and jurisdiction over the establishment and maintenance of public schools and other educational facilities of the Board including playgrounds and other recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 5/34-20 of the Code authorizes acquisition of title to real estate, by purchase, condemnation, or otherwise for school purposes such title to be held for the use and on behalf of the Board in the name of the City of Chicago in Trust for Use of Schools; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2000 the Board adopted Resolution No. 00-1115-RS8 designating the property described on Exhibit A for potential acquisition for a new Mark T. Skinner School; and

WHEREAS, the new Mark T. Skinner School has been constructed and the property described on Exhibit A is not required nor needed for construction or operation of the new Skinner School at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago as follows:

- 1. The property described on Exhibit A is not required for school and other educational purposes at this time.
- 2. The Board hereby de-designates the property described on Exhibit A for acquisition for educational purposes.
- 3. This resolution is effective immediate upon its adoption.
