**RESCIND WARNING RESOLUTION – DAN COYNE,
TENURED TEACHER, CITY WIDE**

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Board of Education of the City of Chicago rescind a Warning Resolution previously issued to Dan Coyne, on May 26, 2010, Board Report No. 10-0526-EX37.

DESCRIPTION: A Warning Resolution was issued to Dan Coyne at the May 26, 2010 meeting of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, Board Report No. 10-0526-EX37, informing him that he was in violation of the Board's Residency Policy. Subsequent to the issuance of the Warning Resolution, the Board's Office of Labor and Employee Relations received additional information that the Board has never sent Dan Coyne an appropriate notification letter that his social worker position was no longer classified as a "special needs" position exempt from the Board's Residency Policy. Accordingly, Dan Coyne had not been appropriately notified that he must become a resident of the City of Chicago within six (6) months from when his position was removed from the "special needs" exemption category. Accordingly, the Warning Resolution was sent prematurely to Dan Coyne without giving him an opportunity to become a resident of the City of Chicago in accordance with the Board's Residency Policy.

Based on the above, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago rescinds Warning Resolution Board Report No. 10-0526-EX37 issued to Dan Coyne at the May 26, 2010 meeting.


