AMEND BOARD REPORT 26-0330-RS2
RESOLUTION TO APPOINT SUPERINTENDENT/CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND TO APPROVE
SUPERINTENDENT/CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT
(DR. MACQUILINE KING)

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has conducted a national search of candidates to fill the position of Superintendent/Chief Executive Officer;

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has offered the position to Dr. Macquiline King and she has accepted the position effective July 1, 2026;

WHEREAS, the Board of Education approved the Resolution to Appoint Chief Executive Officer and to Approve Chief Executive Officer's Employment Contract (Dr. Macquiline King) (26-0330-RS2) on March 30, 2026;

WHEREAS, the Board of Education wishes to amend and ratify the effective date of Dr. King's appointment to March 31, 2026;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- (1) The Board of Education hereby appoints Macquiline King ("King") as Superintendent/Chief Executive Officer.
- (2) The Board of Education delegates to the Board President authority to:
 - (a) Negotiate the terms of an employment contract and any addenda thereto (together "employment contract"); and
 - (b) Execute, subject to approval of the General Counsel, the employment contracts subject to the terms herein.
- (3) The Board of Education approves the employment contract between the Board of Education and Dr. King dated and effective on March 31, 2026 ~~July 1, 2026~~. The employment contract addresses the terms and conditions of Dr. King's employment including, among other things:
 - (a) Starting salary (\$380,000.00);
 - (b) A term beginning March 31, 2026 ~~July 1, 2026~~ and ending June 30, 2029, including option(s) to renew;
 - (c) Benefits (health, vacation, 403b/457 plan participation);
 - (d) the Superintendent/Chief Executive Officer's annual performance goals and annual performance evaluations; and
 - (e) other appropriate employment terms.
- (4) The position to be affected by approval of this action is contained in the FY26 and FY27 department budget.
- (5) A copy of the employment contract shall be filed with the Secretary of the Board of Education.
