














Working smarter raises Chicago's graduation rate





CPS' Black, Latino, and Low-Income students are more likely to graduate H.S. than their peers in similar districts


5-yr high school graduation rates for Black students, by district, 2014.

5-yr high school graduation rates for low-income students, by district, 2014


