# Chicago Board of Education Announces Citywide Community Events for CPS Superintendent/CEO Search

Chicagoans Invited to Share Their voice and Help Shape the Search for the District's Next Leader

**CHICAGO** — The Chicago Board of Education (Board) has announced a series of community gatherings across the city to engage the public in shaping the future of Chicago Public Schools (CPS) and selecting its next Superintendent/CEO. An event will be held in each of the ten CPS Elected School Board districts.

These gatherings are among several opportunities for CPS stakeholders—including students, families, educators, and community members—to provide input during the search process in the weeks ahead.

At its April 24, 2025, meeting, the Board unanimously approved a resolution launching the search and reaffirming its commitment to inclusive stakeholder engagement. Applications for the Superintendent/CEO position opened on April 25, giving candidates a chance to apply before the school year ends.

"We are seeking a leader who will think boldly, embrace innovation, and build an equitable, student-centered future," said Board President Sean B. Harden. "This is a moment of extraordinary promise—and an opportunity to shape the lives of hundreds of thousands of Chicago's students and families."

Following the community engagement period, the Board will review public input in partnership with its executive search firm, Alma Advisory Group. A report of the findings will be made public and used to evaluate candidates.

"We invite all members of the CPS community and Chicagoans to take part in this important process," said Board Member and Transition Team Chair Jessica Biggs. "Your voice will help guide our search for a leader who reflects the hopes and ambitions of our students and families."
