

ISBE Waiver for the Continuous Improvement Work Plan (CIWP)

Waiver Overview



- The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) requires all school districts to file school or district improvement plans using their electronic format
- CPS has developed the electronic Continuous Improvement Work Plan (CIWP) for schools to utilize for its school improvement plans
- CPS would like to use the CIWP instead of ISBE's electronic format

Waiver Renewal



 The district has utilized a waiver to use its own electronic format for the last 5 years. The waiver ended on June 2013, requiring CPS to renew.

- To renew the waiver, the district requires
 - Approval from the board <u>and</u>
 - Approval from ISBE

CIWP



- The CIWP replaced the school improvement plan for advancing academic achievement (SIPAAA)
- Meets state and federal school improvement plan requirements
- Provides a streamlined planning process and tools for monitoring the school's implementation of the plan, and for making adjustments.
- Offers strategic planning for the district, network and school levels

Recommendation



The Chief Executive Officer recommends approving CIWP waiver application.
