### **Nutrition Facts**



CPS is a leader in the School Food Community and prides itself in serving nutritious meals to students that exceed the Federal Guidelines and prepare our students for learning while operating efficiently so as to be self funding.

#### What do we do?

- 75 Million Meals Served

### Who are we?

- 685 Sites Largest Food Service Operation in State
- 2755 CPS Employees solely focused on serving quality meals to students
- All Meals Served Free to Students, students participate voluntarily
- Fully Reimbursed by USDA Community Eligibility Program based on 86% of all students meeting low income thresholds
- Outsourced middle management and procurement to Aramark since FY 2014, has been outsourced for 20 years
- Aramark exceeds M/WBE participation at 34% MBE and 14% WBE
