ONS has shared many resources with schools to support schools sharing their CIWP with the greater school community, including tools and materials to support State of the School addresses. CIWP <a href="#">Progress Monitoring communication and resources</a> have already gone out to schools and network teams. Internal tracking will allow networks to see which schools are monitoring progress toward their CIWP and among those schools, what areas require more support.</p> <p>In addition to the vast array of resources that ONS has shared, the Office of LSC Relations has also shared updated communication, resources, and training on the new CIWP process to ensure a greater connection with the community.</p>	
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
